PE

Focused teaching of PE will be on a **Thursday**. Please bring your child to school wearing their PE kit on Fridays. They will need to bring their school uniform and shoes in a named bag for changing into afterwards. PE will begin on Thursday 19th September.

EYFS children will bring home a 'reading for pleasure book' each week. Please send your child's book back each week so they can swap it. We will let you know when our weekly slot is soon!

A Reminder

Children will need their wellies and a suitable coat at school every day as we play outside in most weathers. They will also need a water bottle.

Health and Safety

In the interests of safety, could you please refrain from letting your children play on the playground equipment (castle, trim trail and bikes) before and after school.

The topic in Term 2 will be 'Celebrations' and we will be learning about different celebrations in many cultures and countries. You will be able to access a 'topic web' and 'knowledge organiser' on the school website and Tapestry at the beginning of each term.

Phonics

We will start teaching phonics using Essential Letters and Sounds on Monday 16th September. You will soon receive a letter inviting you to a meeting about this.

Your child will bring reading books every week. Reading books should be in school daily and will be changed once a week. We will change books that have been read at home so please make sure you record in the yellow reading record. Reading is a vital life skill and in Reception, phonics/reading is a focus area. Please hear your child read at home at least 3 times a week to support their learning at school. Children will receive house points for reading at home!
