We are really excited about our residential visit to PGL next week and the children are too! On the back of this sheet is a copy of the kit list as a reminder of what the children need.

A few things...

Children will need a sleeping bag and a pillow.

It is really important that your child has a named WATER BOTTLE as this is refilled during the day so children can have a drink at any time.

Medication: no medication is to be packed in bags. Mrs Healey and Mrs Lee will be at the top of the Year 3/4 playground to receive it. Please ensure that all medication is labelled with your child's name, the dosage and when it should be administered.

On the morning of departure please could children arrive at 08:30 so that we can depart promptly at 09:00. We ask parents/carers who wish to say goodbye to wait on the playground.

- -The children will leave their bags outside (as long as it's dry) and come into school to be registered, go to the toilet etc.
- -The children will then collect their bags and get on the bus.
- -Please help your child with their bag before saying goodbye. We ask that you say a quick goodbye before your child gets on the bus, to help a smooth departure from school.
- -Finally, with a big smile, wave us off.

On our return we will expect to be back for the end of the school day. A call will be made to school to update our arrival time and you will be informed by email/school coms.

We will be talking to the children this week about routines during our stay (especially bedtime), rules to make sure everyone is safe and how we can make sure that we all have a great time.
